Whereas, Loren Buddress held the position of Chief Probation Officer, San Mateo County, from 1999 through 2008; and

Whereas, Loren Buddress has always been a tireless advocate for youth, heading reform efforts to improve rehabilitation projects and facility conditions for incarcerated youth for the past nine years in San Mateo County and for eleven years prior in San Francisco; and
